CONTEST RULES

This year, The John D. McFadden, Sr. Youth Filmmakers Contest will focus on a modern day American civil rights movement, "Black Lives Matter". Using film as art therapy to express emotions and perceptions through moving pictures, even though this is a heavy subject, be sure to have fun making your movie.

THE RULES:

- Filmmakers must be 6-15 years old
- Filmmakers encouraged to use smart phone and film editing apps to complete film.
- Open to Children From All Over The World
- Film Submissions must be no longer than 5 minutes.
- Film Submissions must be suitable for all-ages. No mature subject matter (ie. murder, substance abuse, violence, coarse language).
- Music should be original copyright, copyright with permission, or public domain, you may use copyrighted music under the Fair Use Laws.
- Film Submissions must be an original work created by the filmmaker or a filmmaking group.
- The film must be completed without professional assistance (mentoring by an adult, whether professional or non-professional, is permitted, but all hands-on efforts must be completed by the submitting filmmaker.
- Film Submissions due date: November 30, 2020
